Napoleon, Wauseon, Archbold, Swanton, Delta, Deshler, Liberty Center, Holgate, McClure, Hamler, Texas, Malinta, Florida, Belmore, New Bavaria, Grelton, Ridgeville Corners, Gerald, Colton, and Tedrow. This includes Interstate 80 in Ohio between mile markers 23 and 48.
