...The Flood Warning continues for the following rivers in Indiana... Ohio...Michigan... Tippecanoe River above Winamac affecting White, Carroll and Pulaski Counties. Tippecanoe River near Ora affecting Pulaski County. Saint Joseph River Ohio near Newville affecting Defiance, Allen IN and De Kalb Counties. Tiffin River at Stryker affecting Defiance, Fulton OH and Williams Counties. Saint Joseph River Michigan at Three Rivers affecting Elkhart, Branch and St. Joseph MI Counties. ...The Flood Warning is extended for the following rivers in Indiana... North Branch Elkhart River at Cosperville affecting Noble County. For the Tippecanoe River...including Ora, Winamac, Norway Dam... Moderate flooding is forecast. For the Saint Joseph River Ohio...including Montpelier, Newville, St. Joe River Ft. Wayne...Minor flooding is forecast. For the Tiffin River...including Stryker...Minor flooding is forecast. For the Elkhart River...including Goshen, Cosperville...Minor flooding is forecast. \* WHAT...Minor flooding is occurring and minor flooding is forecast. \* WHERE...Tiffin River at Stryker. \* WHEN...Until early Friday afternoon. \* IMPACTS...At 13.0 feet, Flood waters begin to affect some farm buildings near Stryker and flood some secondary roads. \* ADDITIONAL DETAILS... - At 10:00 AM EDT Wednesday the stage was 12.6 feet. - Recent Activity...The maximum river stage in the 24 hours ending at 10:00 AM EDT Wednesday was 13.5 feet. - Forecast...The river is expected to fall below flood stage late tomorrow evening and continue falling to 7.7 feet Monday morning. - Flood stage is 11.0 feet. - <http://www.weather.gov/safety/flood>
