At 305 PM EDT, a severe thunderstorm was located over Hicksville, moving east at 45 mph. HAZARD...60 mph wind gusts and quarter size hail. SOURCE...Radar indicated. IMPACT...Hail damage to vehicles is expected. Expect wind damage to roofs, siding, and trees. Locations impacted include... Fort Wayne, Bryan, Hicksville, Paulding, Edgerton, Antwerp, Woodburn, Grabill, St. Joe, Edgerton In Williams County, Leo-cedarville, Farmer, Newville, Ney, Cecil, Williams Center, Harlan, Melbern, Spencerville In Dekalb County, and The Bend. This includes Interstate 469 between mile markers 26 and 29.

Instructions

Prepare immediately for large hail and damaging winds. People outside should move to a shelter, inside a strong building and away from windows. Torrential rainfall is occurring with this storm, and may lead to flash flooding. Do not drive your vehicle through flooded roadways.
