Description

At 423 PM EDT, Doppler radar was tracking a strong thunderstorm over Swanton, moving southeast at 15 mph. HAZARD...Wind gusts up to 40 mph and pea size hail. SOURCE...Radar indicated. IMPACT...Gusty winds could knock down tree limbs and blow around unsecured objects. Minor hail damage to vegetation is possible. Locations impacted include... Toledo, Swanton, Perrysburg, Rossford, Waterville, Northwood, Whitehouse, Holland, Maumee, Haskins, Grand Rapids, Tontogany, and Neapolis.
